Historical Note

Cardinal McCloskey high school was founded in 1957 when Reverend William A. Scully, bishop of Albany, united three small and out-of-date parish schools in the south end district of Albany: St. Anne's, St. John's, and Cathedral. Six Daughters of Charity were recruited to teach, along with diocesan priests, Sisters of St. Joseph, and lay teachers. The composition of the classes was largely low-

and-lower-middle income Italian Americans. In 1967, a new high school was opened at 99 Slingerland Street, which expanded the possibilities of classes, facilities, and extra-curricular activities. In 1974, St. Joseph's High School was merged into Cardinal McCloskey, and Vincentian Institute merged three years later in 1977. This institution was renamed Bishop Maginn High School and operated from the same site as Cardinal McCloskey School.
