### Historical Note

St. Francis Xavier Catholic Church in Gettysburg, Pennsylvania started their parish grade school in 1877 under Pastor Joseph Boll. It was operated by the pastor and several volunteers until 1899, when the Daughters of Charity took over operation after a request by Father T. J. Cottey. In 1920, the Sisters of Mercy began to staff the school.

## Scope and Contents

The bulk of the collection contains materials from the time period from 1899-1920 when the Daughters of Charity staffed and operated the school, including administrative correspondence and financial information. There are also a few published histories of St. Francis Xavier Parish, as well as lists of Daughters of Charity who served at the school.
