Historical Note

Aberdeen Residence was set up for inserted ministries for Daughters of Charity in the West Central Province in 1985 for a variety of nursing and health care missions in close coordination with the Sisters of the Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The House was located in Aberdeen, South Dakota in the Diocese of Sioux Falls as an affiliate house for the Daughters' residence in Eagle Butte, South Dakota. Many of their services benefited the local Native American population in the area. Due to the temporary nature of the inserted ministries, both houses were closed in 1985.

Scope and Contents

Contains documents related to the opening of the Aberdeen residence in Aberdeen, South Dakota and their work in various inserted health care ministries in the Diocese of Sioux Falls, including St. Luke's Hospital, Preservation College School of Nursing, and Mother Joseph Manor retirement facility. Contains records documenting work with Native Americans at the Sioux Indian Retreat House & Center.
