Historical Note

In 1985, the Daughters of Charity, East Central Province were invited by Bishop James Keleher of the Diocese of Belleville to begin ministry in East St. Louis,

Illinois. The home that would become St. Regis Residence was the rectory of St. Regis Parish, which had in turn been donated by a parishioner for use of the church. The Residence was used as the local community home for the Daughters in their inserted ministries in East St. Louis. Among these was work in parish schools, public housing, and social work in a predominantly impoverished African-American neighborhood.

Scope and Contents

This collection contains items related to the local community of the Daughters of Charity established in East St. Louis, Illinois. From here the Daughters worked in inserted ministries in social ministries throughout the city, including Sister Thea Bowman School and Vincent Gray Alternative High School, as well as community organizing, social services, and public housing. It includes reports, correspondence, histories, grant proposals, lease agreements, newspaper articles, photographs, and slides.
