Historical Note

St. Joseph's School was founded in 1810 by Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton in the Emmitsburg, Maryland White House as a school for girls in the region as St. Joseph's School. It is often incorrectly credited as the foundation of Catholic parochial education in the United States. The student body consisted of day students who lived in the area, but within months began admitting tuition-paying pupils. Although it was a Catholic

institution, students of all faith traditions were welcome, with the understanding that education would be consistent with the Catholic faith. The curriculum stressed the liberal arts, as well as the domestic skills such as music and needlework that were deemed practical for young girls to learn.

In 1817, when the governing Sisters of Charity of St. Joseph's believed a level of stability had been reached by the school, they sought and were granted an act of incorporation by the Maryland legislature. In 1820, as enrollment continued to increase, the Sisters constructed a separate building for the day scholars, and by 1826, had begun construction on the DuBois building. In 1828, the School adopted a more advanced curriculum, including rhetoric, philosophy, chemistry, botany, algebra, and astronomy, and the school achieved academy rating. It was at this point that St. Joseph's School adopted the name St. Joseph's Academy. Further expansion and construction occurred in 1836 and 1844.

During the Civil War, enrollment dropped significantly, and the grounds were occupied, in turn, by both Union and Confederate troops, although enrollment grew again after the war ended. Further expansion began in 1871 with the construction of Burlando Hall for the Academy. By the early 1880s, enrollment had severely declined and stagnated, a trend which continued into the early 1900s. As the changes in demographics caused the Academy to broaden its curriculum, the Academy received a charter to re-incorporate as St. Joseph's College in 1902.

Scope and Contents

This collection contains materials related to the administration and student life of St. Joseph's Academy. It includes site plans and maps, detailed information on certain pupils, information on students' artwork and needlework, histories, Directress' correspondence, academic prospectus, histories, schoolbooks, academic catalogues containing graduation information, surviving student writings and journals, and photograph collections and albums. Some of the students' books were promotional tools with authorship from various students created for the 1893 Chicago World's Fair created by students. It also contains surviving student premiums, given as awards to high-achieving students.
