Historical Note

St. Cyprian Parish was established in the early 1950s as a personal parish for African-American Catholics, which also included a school for the Georgetown area. The school closed in 1991, and, in 1993, the Daughters of Charity began ministry in the area with the affiliated St. Cyprian House. In this same year, the Daughters and the Parish opened St. Cyprian Outreach Center to provide economic assistance to those in the area, as well as a thrift store and food pantry.

Scope and Contents

This collection contains information about the Daughters of Charity and their work with St. Cyprian Parish and Outreach Center in Georgetown, SC. It includes documents related to the Diocese of Charleston, SC; journals of the sisters; correspondence; newsletters; parish brochures and directories; and scrapbooks.
